

- List all the motivations for holiness that Peter provides in verses 13–21.
- How do these verses undermine the common idea that "those who are heavenly-minded are no earthly good"?
- Why is it important that the Father judges our works without playing favorites? (v. 17)
- How does Jesus' sacrifice motivate holiness?
- How does holiness flow from our identity in Christ? How do you hunger for holiness now?
