DISCIPLESHIP QUESTIONS

- Take note of any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text to share with the group. What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- Talk about a time in your life when you lost something of great value to you. What did you learn about yourself from it? What was difficult about it?
- What is the purpose of fasting in the Bible? Have you ever participated in fasting before? What was your experience like? Was it from food or social media? Tv?
- How does Materialism blind us? Why is it so difficult to understand when we are greedy?
- Jesus talks about earthly treasures and heavenly treasures. What does it mean to store up heavenly treasures? What does your heart treasure the most? Is treasuring earthly things bad?
- How does Jesus's example about the eye in verse 22 fit in with this section on wealth and treasure?
- What does Jesus mean to serve money? Why is it that those who serve money can't serve God? Why can't we do both?
- Take this time to think about where you spend your money and how it affects your day to day life. Does it reveal what you treasure? Where might you need to confess where you are greedy?
