
TRUE FREEDOM

- How does Paul view the law in this text (v. 4, 14)? How does the gospel help us understand this contrast?
- What other voices are subtly "calling" for your trust and allegiance (v. 8, 13)?
- Consider the contrast of v. 13 and 15. How is your life reflective of both?
