SERMON QUESTIONS

- Before traveling across the sea, Mark tells us that Jesus was teaching. Read Mark 4:1-34. How would you summarize Jesus' message?
- Do you think the disciples had good reason to be afraid in the storm on the sea? Why or why not? What do you make of Jesus' question to them in verse 40?
- What did the disciples learn about Jesus as a result of their experience on the sea? Look up Psalm 65:5-8. What do these verses teach about who has power over the sea?
- In chapter 5, Jesus and the disciples move out of a storm at sea and into a "storm" on land. Why do you think the people from the city and the country implored Jesus to leave in verse 17? How does their response relate to Jesus' teaching in chapter 4?
- Just as Jesus sent the man who was demon-possessed on His mission, so Jesus sends us today. Make a quick list of some of the great things God has done for you. Who might God want you to share your list with this week?
