

- How is the church involved in the mission of God through the sending of these two?
- What promises did God fulfill by raising Jesus? (see v. 32-33 and following).
- How do these Old Testament texts support the point? (see v. 33-41)
- Discuss the description of David, "he had served the purpose of God in his own generation..." (v. 36)
- What can Jesus free us from that the Law of Moses can't free us from? (see v. 38–39)
- How does this passage challenge, encourage or equip you to be faithful to Jesus?
